“Medicine Woman in the Amazon”

Cecilia Carrick M.D., will describe her fascinating experience running the medical laboratory at the Hospital Amazonico de Yarinacocha for six weeks in the remote Peruvian Amazon jungle. She will share the challenges of bringing medical supplies, equipment and training to assist some of the poorest people on earth.
