Our November meeting

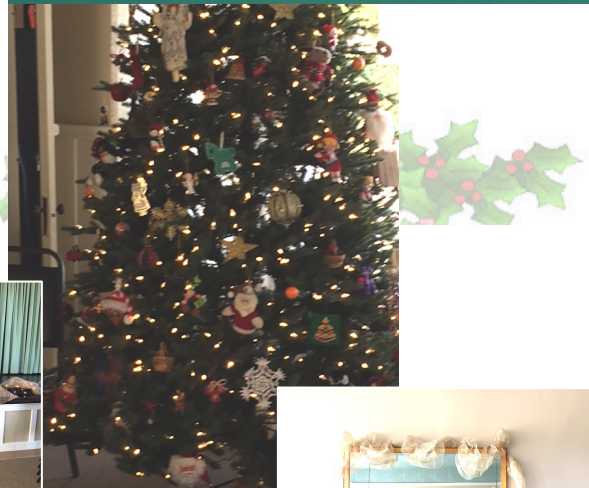
