After waiting since the fall of 2017, we are pleased to finally see our monument sign in place at 3035 Talbot.

. This sign establishes our identity in this community as an organization and as owners of this beautiful building. Many thanks go out to Pat Baker's committee including Victory Lareau, Dottie Laub, Pat Horvath, Sandy Perlatti, and Klonie Kunzel, as well as to Aaron Clippinger of Intergrated Signs who worked with the committee to take the design from an initial proposal to the final concept.

At first our sign permit was denied, but Pam Hamilton Lester enlisted the help of retired City Planning Department employee and Point Loma Assembly member Betsy McCullough to help us figure this out. We waited through multiple rounds of action and revisions by the San Diego City Council and the Coastal Commission. The last time-consuming step on our part was to be sure that we could match the color of the sign to the color of the doors of the building.

The sign was finally installed in July 2019. So it was a really long process but we hope that everyone thinks it was worth the wait.

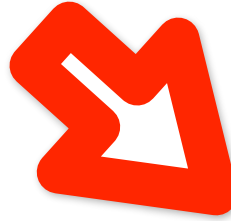


## Speed The Plow
