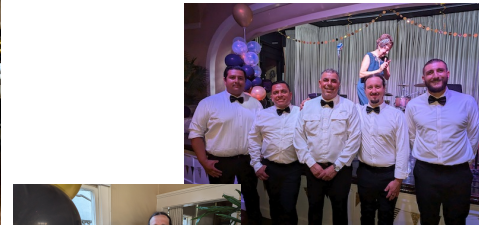

But much of our financial focus has been on this historic home – the Point Loma Assembly building itself.
